Native Plant Trail

We have a two-phase project to create a Native Plant Trail, where many of these sponsored items live. This Trail has been carefully planned to ensure that we have the right plants in the best places. The first phase, which is nearing completion, incorporates a range of carefully selected native plants, with a special focus on medicinal plants. During the second phase we will introduce a number of plants designated "at-risk" or "to watch" that are native to our area.

We are listed on the National Registry of Botanical Plant Sanctuaries. With the help of United Plant Savers we will introduce endangered plants and carefully foster them. We are also a certified Native Plant Habitat through the North Carolina Native Plant Society.

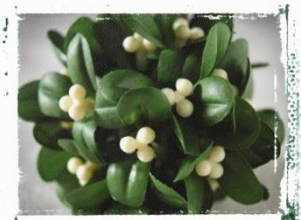

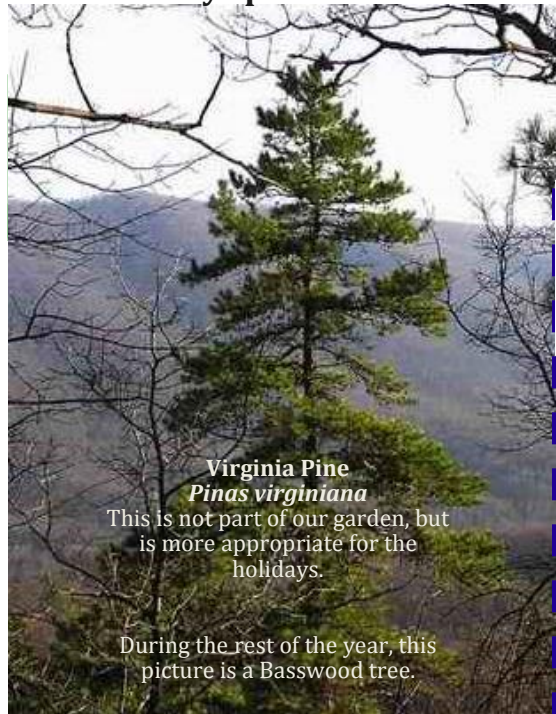
